

Training of PWDs on Vocational Skills Commenced

Seven people with disabilities/PWDs/ started a two months training on shoe production at Menagasha Rehabilitation Center- Shoe Production Workshop on July 4, 2012. The trainees came from Walmara district of West Showa Zone. One of the trainees said that the training would enable him to generate income and economically independent.

Since its establishment, Cheshire Services Ethiopia has enabled a number of PWDs to help themselves. The training is run by the collaboration of CSE with People in Need, a Czech international NGO. The economic empowerment program which is aimed at addressing the self employment problems of persons with disabilities is one of the programs of CSE.

At the end of the training, the trainees will be given materials that support them to start their own business. These kind of practical skill trainings are very important in changing the life of PWDs and should be strengthened both financially and materially.
